Minutes of the April 9, 2018 Records Commission

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m.

Roll Call:

Mayor: Lynn Eisentrout Chief of Police: Kim Nuesse Fiscal Officer: Kim Pulley Solicitor: Gene Hollins

Council President: Jen Pauken Clerk of Courts: Leah Forren Citizen-at-Large: Pam Park-Curry

New Business:

- ❖ The goal of the meeting is to review the records retention schedules. A copy of the retention schedule from March 2009 was distributed.
- ❖ The Mayor's Court Schedule does not list case files, but it is in the police retention schedule. The Clerk would like to add the case files to the Mayor's Court schedule, because that is the Ohio Historical Society's recommendation.
- Chief Nuesse stated that PD 24 Cruiser Log Sheets are no longer kept in paper format, they are all electronic. PD 26 Cruiser Video Tapes should be 90 days. The Clerk of Courts stated that there are no more VHS tapes, and Council President Pauken said it should be changed to Cruiser Recordings. PD 23 also should be changed to 90 days. Council President Pauken asked where the designation was for body cam footage. The Clerk of Courts stated that that was an item that needed to be added. The Ohio Historical Society's recommendation for solicitor's permits is one year after expiration (PD 58). Right now, it is listed as 5 years. Chief Nuesse said that PD 17, PD 29, and PD 43 should be electronic. Council President Pauken asked if it would be more efficient to assume that everything paper has an electronic component and to make that change throughout the schedule. There was agreement for this change. Chief Nuesse stated that they do not keep run sheets, and they are not called run sheets, they are called Call Logs (PD 73). They are kept on the Ohio Attorney General's server. Chief Nuesse said that they have the ability to print them off, but that the AG maintains that database.
- ❖ Mr. Hollins stated that when the meeting is concluded today, that every department's record retention schedule should be updated accordingly with the agreed upon changes. Then, they will be sent to the Ohio Historical Society for approval.
- ❖ Council President Pauken asked where this document lives and who maintains it. She was concerned that there were multiple versions that were named the same thing. Pam Park-Curry asked if we had a Clerk Treasurer and if the Clerk Treasurer is responsible for records retention. The only records retention schedule document that was found was on the server and it was a scanned copy.
- ❖ Pam Park-Curry asked if anyone has been able to get on the silo. Only Council President Pauken has access at this point, the Fiscal Officer and Administrative Assistant do not have usernames and passwords for the silo.
- ❖ Mayor Eisentrout asked how long emails must be kept after a project is finished. Mr. Hollins said that those are typically "non-record messages." Those are messages that do not serve to function or to document the functions of the village are non-record and are delete at will. Record messages are

those that serve to document that ongoing operation function of the village. Using email as a repository of important document is discouraged. Emails can be deleted when they are no longer of administrative value.

- ❖ Pam Park-Curry had a question about annexation. The record retention schedule said that it is permanent, but she would like to know where those are located. She asked if it was on the silo or at fireproof. She asked if there were building plans for residential and commercial properties and if they can be scanned.
- ❖ Council President Pauken asked about the state of the records in the basement, if they are too moldy. Chief Nuesse said that a few of those boxes have mold in them still.
- ❖ Mr. Hollins said that the Ohio Historical Society recognizes two forms of permanent retention and scanning is not one of them.
- ❖ Council President Pauken asked about the audio and video recordings of meetings. They need to be added to the schedule. There are no official meeting minutes for work sessions, but there are videos of work sessions. Committee meetings are also audio videos. It was determined that by the next meeting, the administrative assistant would look into getting the videos downloaded from Facebook.
- ❖ It was agreed that the Clerk of Courts would be requesting the official record retention schedule from the Ohio Historical Society so that way the changes can be made and then in a few months, the records commission would meet to approve those changes.
- ❖ The next meeting was set for Monday, June 11, 2018 at 2:00 p.m.

- **Section 2.** The Fiscal Officer is authorized to convert \$11,862.54 of the amount advanced to the Dam and Lake Improvement fund to a transfer which will not be repaid. The Fiscal Officer is authorized to return the remaining \$38,137.46 to the General fund as repayment of the advance.
- **Section 3.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinances were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.
- **Section 4.** This resolution shall take effect and shall be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.



FENCE EASEMENT AGREEMENT


