

MAYOR'S COURT NOTICE OF CONTINUANCE TO MAY 6, 2020

TEMPORARY ORDER OF THE COURT

On March 9, 2020, Ohio Governor Mike DeWine issued Executive Order 2020-01D, declaring a State of Emergency in response to the growing COVID-19 public health emergency.

In response to this public health emergency, the Minerva Park Mayor's Court is taking measures to minimize the number of people in the community building in the coming weeks. Therefore, Minerva Park Mayor's Court is modifying its schedule in order to protect the public while maintaining essential court functions and protecting the rights of all individuals subject to the authority of the Court.

Therefore, it is hereby ordered:


1. Effective March 16th, 2020, all pending cases, including criminal and traffic arraignments, pre-trials, trials, and hearings will be continued 7 weeks from their original court date or to a date as determined by further order of this Court.
2. Upon the Court's own motion and for good cause shown, all cases in which the defendant has not waived their right to a speedy trial, will be continued in the same manner as above, pursuant to ORC 2945.72(H). In light of the public health emergency, the Court finds that such a continuance is not only reasonable, but necessary to protect public health.
