A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A RANGE FOR HOURLY RATE PAY FOR THE PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS OF THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT, FRANKLIN COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Minerva Park employs part-time police officers in the Minerva Park Police Department; and

WHEREAS, hourly wages for part-time police officers were previously set by Resolution 2003-18; and

WHEREAS, to remain competitive with surrounding communities' pay rates for part-time police officers, it is now necessary to set a higher range for the hourly pay of the part-time officers of the Village of Minerva Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Minerva Park, Franklin County, State of Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The hourly rate of pay range for part-time police officers of the Village of Minerva Park shall be increased to between \$18.01 and \$22.00 an hour.
- Section 2. This new pay schedule will begin June 1, 2007.
- Section 3. All prior resolution(s) or any part thereof, which is(are) inconsistent with this resolution, is(are) hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part(s) thereof, and the remainder of said resolution(s) not inconsistent with this resolution shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 4. Council declares this resolution to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Minerva Park, such emergency arising from the need to continue quality police protection for the Village and its residents. Wherefore, this resolution shall take effect and be in full force on June 1, 2007.
