- Section 4. Council declares this to be an emergency measure necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Minerva Park, such emergency arising from the need to have a Public Records Policy to help govern public records requests of the Village. Wherefore, this resolution shall take effect and shall be in force upon its passage.
