

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TREASURER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT FOR THE 2009 STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT ON SPECIFIED STREETS IN THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there presently exists a need for reconstruction of sections of East Shore Drive, Berry Lane Court, East Shore Court, North Lake Court, Kerrwood Drive, Ponderosa Drive, and Alder Vista Drive; and

WHEREAS, the construction contract was put out for bid and bids were received in accordance with the law; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Minerva Park, Franklin County, State of Ohio, that:

- Section 1. The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into contract, a copy of which is marked Exhibit A and attached hereto, on behalf of the Village of Minerva Park, with Strawser Paving, for the street reconstruction project listed above.
- Section 2. Strawser Paving was considered the lowest and best bidder with a total bid of \$173,442.04 and is therefore awarded the contract.
- Section 3. All prior resolution(s) or any part thereof, which is(are) inconsistent with this resolution is(are) hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part(s) thereof, and the remainder of said resolution(s) not inconsistent with this resolution shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 4. Council declares this to be an emergency measure necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Minerva Park, such emergency arising out of the need to meet the construction time schedule set forth in the aforementioned contract. Wherefore, this resolution shall take effect and shall be in force upon its passage.
