

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TREASURER OF THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF BLENDON CONCERNING THE CONTINUED PROVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL AID SERVICE TO THE RESIDENTS OF BLENDON TOWNSHIP BY THE MINERVA PARK VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Minerva Park maintains a Volunteer Fire Department that provides emergency medical aid service to its residents and to the residents of neighboring districts, and

WHEREAS, the Township of Blendon is a neighboring district that desires the emergency medical aid services provided by the Minerva Park Volunteer Fire Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Minerva Park, Franklin County, State of Ohio, that:

- Section 1. The Mayor and the Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement on behalf of the Village of Minerva Park, whereby the Minerva Park Volunteer Fire Department will furnish emergency medical aid services to the Township of Blendon, for which the Township will provide annually eleven thousand five hundred dollars (\$11,500) for 2010 and thirteen thousand dollars (\$13,000) for 2011. A copy of this agreement is marked Exhibit A and is made part hereof as if fully written herein.
- Section 2. This contract will remain in effect unless terminated by 30 days notice in writing by either party mentioned.
- Section 3. All prior resolution(s) or any part thereof, which is(are) inconsistent with this resolution is(are) hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part(s) thereof, and the remainder of said resolution(s) not inconsistent with this resolution shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 4. Council declares this to be an emergency measure necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Minerva Park, such emergency arising from the need to have a contract in place by January 1, 2010. Wherefore, this resolution shall take effect and shall be in force upon its passage.
