

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING 13-92 REGARDING COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH AND MEDICAL TESTING PROGRAM FOR POLICE OFFICERS OF THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK

WHEREAS, Ordinance 13-92 established various health and medical testing programs for police officers of the Village of Minerva Park; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Minerva Park wishes revisit such medical check-up requirements and potentially bring those requirements current with commonly accepted practices;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Minerva Park, Franklin County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Ordinance 13-92 is repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Medical check-up programs for police personnel may be set forth in various employee Police Department policies and employee manuals as adopted by Council by resolution from time to time, reflecting current, commonly accepted standards.

Section 3. All prior ordinance(s) or resolution(s) or any part thereof, which is(are) inconsistent with this ordinance or resolution is(are) hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part(s) thereof and the remainder of said ordinance(s) or resolution(s) not inconsistent with this resolution shall remain in full force and effect..

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and shall be in force at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.
