**A RESOLUTION APPROVING TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS OF FUNDS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK FOR THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1, 2013 AND ENDING MARCH 31, 2013**






