A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DONATION OF ADDITIONAL PORTABLE AND MOBILE RADIOS AND OTHER EQUIPMENT FROM FRANKLIN COUNTY OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND RATIFYING PRIOR RECEIPT OF EQUIPMENT RECEIVED FROM FRANKLIN COUNTY OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN 2012 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office of Homeland Security is desirous of donating two portable radios with chargers and two extra batteries and a mobile radio to the Village of Minerva Park for the purposes of aiding the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office of Homeland Security previously donated two portable radios with chargers and two extra batteries in 2012 to the Village of Minerva Park for the purposes of aiding the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Minerva Park wants to accept and ratify this generous donation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. The Village of Minerva Park hereby accepts the Franklin County Department of Homeland Security's donation of two portable radios with chargers and two extra batteries and a mobile radio valued at \$8,489.25 and more particularly identified on the list attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.


Section 2. The Village of Minerva Park hereby ratifies the Franklin County Department of Homeland Security's donation in 2012 of two portable radios with chargers and two extra batteries valued at \$5,717.50 and more particularly identified on the list attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3. All prior ordinance(s) or resolution(s) or any part thereof, which is (are) consistent with this ordinance or resolution is (are) hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part(s) thereof and the remainder of said ordinance(s) or resolution(s) not inconsistent with this resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, such emergency and the further reason that the Village wants to acquire and use this property immediately; WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
