A RESOLUTION APPROVING TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS OF FUNDS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK FOR THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1, 2014 AND ENDING MARCH 31, 2014

Section 3. This resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage.


