

ORDINANCE 01-2014

This ordinance is passed only if the ballot issue passes

AN ORDINANCE TO ENACT AN INCREASE IN THE VILLAGE INCOME TAX RATE FROM THE CURRENT RATE OF ONE PERCENT (1.0%) TO A RATE OF TWO PERCENT (2 %) TO BECOME EFFECTIVE ON JANUARY 1, 2015 FOR THE PURPOSES OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL OPERATIONS AND SERVICES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, POLICE SERVICES, STREET MAINTENANCE, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, AND RELATED COSTS OF THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK, OHIO THAT:

- Section 1. Effective January 1, 2015, in addition to the tax imposed by Ordinance No. 07-2004 and Ordinance No. 01-2013, there is levied an additional tax of one percent (1%) upon those classes of salaries, wages, commissions, rent, compensation and profits set forth in Ordinance No. 07-2004 and Ordinance No. 01-2013, for the purposes of general municipal operations and services, including, but not limited to, police services, street maintenance, capital improvements, and related costs of the Village.
- Section 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.
- Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village and for the further reason that the additional tax of one percent (1%) provided for herein is pursuant to the approval of the electors of the Village and is to be effective January 1, 2015, in order to provide funding necessary for general municipal operations and services, including, but not limited to, police services, street maintenance, capital improvements, and related costs of the Village; WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.


