

ORDINANCE 08-2015

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE APPROPRIATIONS AND AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS

WHEREAS, The Village spent money in prior years from the General Fund recovering from a destructive storm;

WHEREAS, The State and Federal Emergency Management Agency reimbursed the Village for a portion of those costs;

WHEREAS, The grant money was receipted into the FEMA Fund as required by the Auditor of State Bulletin 98-013;

WHEREAS, This bulletin further states that money reimbursed by FEMA may be transferred to the fund from which the original expenditures were made; and,

WHEREAS, The Council desires to utilize these funds for the purchase of a new EMS vehicle.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to transfer the balance in the FEMA Grant Fund of \$6,295 to the General Fund.

Section 2. The appropriations in the General Fund for the transfer of fund is amended as follows:

Section 3. Upon receipt of the FEMA funds into the General Fund the Fiscal Officer is authorized to transfer \$6,295 to the EMS Vehicle fund.

Section 4. All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.





Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


