

ORDINANCE 12-2015

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT FOR THE NEW EMS VEHICLE THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM AND OTHER VENDORS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has identified a need within the Fire/EMS Department for a new EMS vehicle to provide ongoing services; and

WHEREAS, Council authorized the purchase of a 2015/2016 Ford E-450 6.8 V-10 gas engine type III Medix Metro Express 166 modular type III vehicle in Ordinance 11-2015 through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and;

WHEREAS, The new vehicle requires certain equipment upgrades in order to continue providing EMS services which are not part of or provided by the vehicle vendor; and

WHEREAS, certain equipment upgrades are available through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program and other vendors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK, OHIO, THAT;

Section 1. The Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to enter into contracts under the State of Ohio Competitive Bidding Purchase Program and other vendors for EMS vehicle equipment as listed below:




