

## RESOLUTION 2015-46

### A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF GEORGE FRANNEY AS A PART-TIME POLICE OFFICER FOR THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, there is a vacancy in the Village of Minerva Park Police Department for a part-time officer; and,


**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council for the Village of Minerva Park wish to fill the this position, and,

**WHEREAS**, George Franey will begin serving as a part-time Police Officer in the Minerva Park Police Department on November 25, 2015, and has the necessary qualifications to for the position; and,

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 737.16, Revised Code, the Mayor appointed George Franey as a part-time Police Officer for the Village of Minerva Park to begin on November 25, 2015 and Council for the Village of Minerva Park now wishes to confirm this appointment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK, OHIO THAT:**

- Section 1.** Pursuant to section 737.16, Revised Code, Council for the Village of Minerva Park hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of George Franey as a part-time Police Officer beginning November 25, 2015, at a rate of \$18.00 per hour to be scheduled as needed.
- Section 2.** Pursuant to Section 737.17, Revised Code, this appointment and confirmation shall be for a probationary period of six months' consecutive service, and shall not be finally made until George Franey has satisfactorily served the probationary period and the Mayor, with the concurrence of Council, have finally appointed George Franey.
- Section 3.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.
- Section 4.** Council declares this to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Minerva Park, such emergency arising out of the immediate need to fill the part-time officer position. Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and shall be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
