

RESOLUTION 2016-36

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL FOR DEBT COLLECTIONS

WHEREAS, the Village of Minerva Park (“Village”) desires to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Attorney General for the collection of debts including but not limited to delinquent Mayor’s Court cases; and,

WHEREAS, the cost of collections is passed on to the debtor; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Fiscal Officer of the Village are authorized to enter into a contract with the Ohio Attorney General for the collection of debts owed to the Village and the Village’s Mayor’s Court.

Section 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect and be in full force from the earliest period allowed by law.
