A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF KYLE SMITH AS A FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICER FOR THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Minerva Park passed Resolution 2017-24 on August 14, 2017 confirming the appointment of Kyle Smith as a part-time police officer; and

WHEREAS, Kyle Smith was promoted to full-time employment on October 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Minerva Park acknowledges the successful completion of the probationary period set forth in R.C. § 737.17 by Kyle Smith, the transmittal by the Mayor of a record of Kyle Smith's service during the probationary period, and the Mayor's recommendation to affirm the appointment of Kyle Smith as a full-time officer for the Village of Minerva Park; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Minerva Park desires to concur with the recommendation of the Mayor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby concurs with the recommendation by the Mayor to affirm the appointment of Kyle Smith as a full-time police officer for the Village of Minerva Park effective April 1, 2018.

Section 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

Section 3. All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

Section 4. Council declares this to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Minerva Park, such emergency arising out of the immediate need affirm the appointment of Kyle Smith at the end of his probationary period. Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and shall be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
