

Resolution 2019-30

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF A FISCAL OFFICER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the current Fiscal Officer, Kim Pulley, has announced she is leaving the position of Minerva Park Fiscal Officer effective October 21, 2019;

WHEREAS, the Village of Minerva Park ("Village") deems it necessary to have the Fiscal Officer position filled without interruption; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §733.262, the Mayor has appointed Jeanetta Anderson as Fiscal Officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Minerva Park, Franklin County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Council hereby approves the appointment by the Mayor of Jeanetta Anderson to serve as full-time Fiscal Officer for the Village with an annual salary of \$60,000, effective November 9, 2019. Pursuant to RC 733.262, Council hereby approves the Fiscal Officer's residence outside the Village of Minerva Park.

Section 2. Council further authorizes the Mayor to continue the part-time employment of Kim Pulley so that her employment will overlap with the new Fiscal Officer through November 25, 2019 to assist in the transition.

Section 3. The Mayor, Fiscal Officer, and Law Director are hereby authorized to take further actions consistent with this Ordinance that are needed to carry out the intentions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

Section 5. All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

Section 6. Council declares this to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Minerva Park, such emergency arising out of the need to have the Fiscal Officer position filled without interruption. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and shall be in force immediately upon passage by Council.
