The Records Commission met on March 26, after the deadline for this publication. On the same day, we had a tentative call scheduled with the vendor who is handling the codification of Village ordinances. Details about those meetings will appear in the next Village Update.

Legislation from February 26 through March 12 includes:

- 2018-03 - Pool Fees, Three readings, passed
- 2018-04 - Police Vehicle Equipment, Three readings, passed

- 2018-05 - Rules of Council Revision, Three readings, passed
- 1-2018 - Technical Correction to Ordinance 12-2017, Three readings, passed as an emergency
- 3-2018 - Parking During Snowfalls, Two readings
- 4-2018 - Salary Ranges and Positions, Two readings, passed as an emergency
- 5-2018 - Supplemental Appropriations, Two readings, passed

The next legislative committee meeting will be April 23 at 6:30 p.m. This is a standing meeting that will occur each month before the second regular council meeting, and residents are welcome to attend.

Many residents expressed a desire to be involved in discussions about building needs in the Village. We are preparing to form a committee to dig in and come up with a master plan. First, want and need to hear the ideas and concerns of the community. Two meeting dates and times are scheduled to give as many people as possible an opportunity to participate. This is also an opportunity to meet other residents. Councilmember Diane Schrimpf will be facilitating the meetings – which will be conducted as an informal “workshop” where residents will work together in small

groups to discuss ideas. We think it is possible other areas such as the lakes, green space or creation of a Charter Village might come up during our workshop. We will “park” those ideas to share with Council. At the workshops we will have forms for residents to complete if they would like to be on a committee or would like to share expertise, or participate in future discussions about topics of interest.
