Mayor's Report

Pool: We had a good summer for the pool. The revenue is \$53,160, not including income from the vending machines. There will be more expenses to pay as the last of the chemical, water, electric, etc., invoices are received. Once the books are closed for this season, I will share the final numbers with you. I hope to have an end-of-the-season meeting with our pool manager in October to discuss much-needed repairs and upcoming large remediation projects. Stay tuned.

Lakes: I have been in contact with the Army Corps of Engineers and a commercial vendor about the lake dredging project. I plan to focus primarily on this project through the winter months. This will include a dialog with the City of Columbus about debris coming downstream, what can be done about erosion in the ravine areas, and installation of trash racks.

The fallen trees have been removed from the North Lake and along the shoreline.

Reminder: Please do not leave grass clipping in the street. We have asked this so many times that I have lost count. Grass clippings and leaves left in the street flow down into the storm sewer drains and clog them. Streets become flooded, and residents become frustrated. While we do have our maintenance person inspect and clear the sewer grates whenever possible, especially when we

anticipate a heavy rainfall, it doesn't always work out that way. Please do your part and don't create the problem in the first place.

Basketball Court: M/I Homes has generously agreed to pour a 90 sq.ft. concrete pad for a basketball court at no charge to the Village. Our costs will be the basketball equipment, striping the court, and fencing around the court. While we have discussed installing this at the current playground site, we have not decided on the exact site yet. I want to talk to the neighbors near the playground and to the Planning and Zoning Board before we decide on its placement.

Leaf Pick-up: The Council will award the contract for leaf removal at the September 24 Council meeting. Please do not put your leaves in the street. As stated above, they too will clog the storm sewer drains. Leaves left piled on the lawn for several days will not kill the grass underneath them. Read the November Village Update for the beginning and end pick-up dates (normally mid October to mid December, depending on accumulation).
